All exhibits to be grown by the exhibitor (**except Floral Art section**).

All exhibits to be staged by **10.30am Saturday 26th April 2025** and the hall cleared for judging.

The decision of the Judges shall be final in all cases.

The Judges may withhold or modify the placings if the exhibits are considered of insufficient merit.

Exhibitors and Judges - Note that in all classes other than Large Exhibition, foliage counts in judging.

Points to count for First Prize: 1st = 3 points 2nd = 2 points 3rd = 1 point.

An entry awarded a Best Exhibit Certificate will count 3 points towards the points in its section and the Champion Bloom will count a further 3 points.
